Lettuce



Three lettuce varieties will do well here but two of them may be hard to find seed for. Any lettuce will require protection from freezing temperatures.

Oak Leaf. This lettuce has performed here in the heat of summer. Not the most productive lettuce but the only one we know of that has made it through most of the summer. Seed may be hard to find.

Crawford Reseeding. This is a good leaf lettuce for this area when grown in the cooler times of year. (Protect from freezing temperatures)

Butter Crunch. No lettuce we know of performs better for us through the cooler times of year than Butter Crunch. With a nice flavor and a full bunch, this leaf lettuce is the one we plant at the Eggleston Children's Garden.
