Satsuma Oranges. Satsumas are a variety of orange that has proven to be more cold hardy than most in this area. Satsumas are also called tangerines. There are many different cultivars or types of satsumas. These are some of the varieties that have performed well here.

Orange Frost. This is a relatively new Satsuma developed by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service. It has good flavor and is a dependable producer. It is also growing on its own roots and is not a grafted tree, so even if it freezes down, many trees will come back from their roots. Extension specialists claim that this tree will perform all the way into the Hill Country.

Brown Select. Not as cold hardy as Orange Frost, Brown Select is a medium size tree with very sweet and seedless fruit.
