

Water Oak

(aka Pin Oak) (*Quercus nigra*) Native



The Water Oak is a large tree reaching 90 feet with a dense, somewhat tight crown. It occurs most often near a permanent water source such as swamps, streams and bottom lands. It will require more water than most oaks but is a lovely tree if properly place.
